# **Studio Guidelines**

#### **General Guidelines**

- No Food or Drinks in the Practice Studios. Bottled water is permitted, so long as it is covered with a tight lid. Chewing gum during practice is not permitted.
- **Keep Noise Levels to a Minimum in the Hallways.** The Youth Arts Academy space is shared with several music studios and administrative offices.
- Clean Up After Yourself. Leave the studios and common spaces better than how you found them. Throw away and recycle all trash.
- No Horseplay in the Lobby, Halls, or Rehearsal Spaces. Please be aware of proper safety and care for yourself, others around you, the studio, and musical instruments.
- No Cursing, Strong Language, or Language with the Intention of Hurting Others. Youth Arts Academy is a safe space for people of all ages, please be respectful of those around you.
- You are Responsible for your Instruments, Equipment, and Materials.
   Please take care of these items and be prepared with them before your lesson or practice.
- **Dress Appropriately.** Clothing must cover all undergarments. Shirts must fully cover one's midriff. Shorts must have at least a three-inch inseam. Clothing should not have offensive language or graphics (profanity, derogatory language, or messages associated with mature or illegal substances). Closed toed shoes are required.

# **Student Expectations**

- Students will be open and eager to improve their personal growth, creativity, and self-expression.
- Students will make a commitment to be courteous & respectful at all times.
- Students will **refrain from involving themselves** in gossip, aggressive language, profanity, put downs or criticisms, negative jokes, and viewing or sharing negative images or videos while at Youth Arts Academy.
- Students will **be prepared** for their lessons by familiarizing themselves with their music, practicing, and bringing sheet music to their lessons.
- Students will **remain positive** and approach every idea as an opportunity to grow and learn.
- Students will **be on time** for their lessons, with their instrument(s) warmed up and tuned, their music ready, and their pencil ready to take notes.
- Students will involve an adult when they hear other students discussing abuse or neglect as soon as possible, in order to keep everyone safe. Youth Arts Academy Staff, as employees of Boys & Girls Clubs of San Dieguito, are mandated reporters.
- Students will **practice in order to make progress**, demonstrating a willingness to learn new things and a commitment to respecting others.
- Students will **speak up** if they have an idea to share or if they feel uncomfortable with a choice that is made.

# **Parent/Guardian Expectations**

- Guardians will keep their child at home if feeling ill.
- Guardians will **serve as the main point of communication** between their child and instructor for lesson assignments.
- Guardians will **communicate desires** for lesson date/time changes or cancellations in a timely fashion to Youth Arts Academy administration.
- Guardians will designate a quiet place and space in their home for their student to complete weekly assignments.
- Guardians will **monitor their child's weekly practice time** and weekly assignments.
- Guardians will **establish routines and schedules** to help their child participate in their music learning for the week.
- Guardians will actively participate in their child's at home practice as much as possible.
- Guardians will be mindful of their child's wellbeing. Speak to them
  regularly about their lessons and practice, their feelings and share any
  concerns with their instructor or Youth Arts Academy staff.
- Guardians will **encourage children to participate** in performances and events Youth Arts Academy puts on.

# **Consequences for Violations**

#### First Offense

Verbal Warning from Instructor

#### **Second Offense**

- Notification to Program Manager and Parents
- Written Documentation from Program Manager

#### **Third Offense**

- Notification to Program Manager and Parents
- Written Documentation from Program Manager
- Suspension from Practice, Performance Events, etc.

#### **Fourth Offense**

- Notification to Program Manager and Parents
- Written Documentation from Program Manager
- Expulsion from Program (fees may not be refunded or credited)

# **Private Lessons**

#### Monthly Lesson Fees:

Youth Arts Academy students pay a flat rate monthly membership fee to attend 30 or 60 minute weekly private lessons. Payment is processed via automatic billing on the 1st of every month.

# **Tuition Options**

- \$160 per month for weekly 30-minute lessons
- \$320 per month for weekly 60-minute lessons

Financial Assistance is available to those who qualify. Please contact YAA@BGCSanDieguito.org to receive more information.

Tuition is based on an average of four lessons per month throughout the calendar year and **is not increased or decreased for longer or shorter months**. The monthly rate will remain the same regardless of how many lessons you receive in a month.

## Instruments

Students must bring their own instruments to each lesson. Youth Arts Academy does offer instrument rental for an additional fee. Contact the Youth Arts Academy administrative team for more details.

# **Schedule Changes**

To change the regularly scheduled day and/or time of your lesson, please contact Youth Arts Academy at least two weeks in advance of the change. We cannot guarantee instructor availability for changes, but we will do our best to accommodate your needs.

To withdraw from lessons, you must inform Youth Arts Academy by the 15<sup>th</sup> of the month you wish to withdraw from lessons, to stop billing for the following month. This allows the studio reasonable time to stop payments and allows time to fill the spot with a new student.

## Missed Lessons Due to Student Absence

If you are going to miss a lesson or rehearsal, please notify Youth Arts Academy as soon as possible by emailing YAA@BGCSanDieguito.org. For same-day changes please call or text 858-224-3675.

- More than 24 hours' notice: We will be able to offer a reschedule for your lesson, based on Instructor availability. You MUST reschedule within one week of the missed lesson, or you forfeit your right to reschedule the lesson.
  - We DO NOT offer credits or refunds if instructors are available, but you do not reschedule your lesson.
  - o If the instructor does not have any open availability, the lesson will be credited to your next month's bill.
- Less than 24 hours' notice: we DO NOT offer reschedules, credits, or refunds. Because our music instructors are part-time hourly employees, they will be paid for the lesson even if the student does not attend.

## Missed Lessons Due to Teacher Absence

Instructors may have to cancel lessons due to vacation, illness, or conflicts in their schedule. We will do our best to give students and families at least 24-hour notice of any cancellations.

Students will be given an opportunity to schedule a make-up lesson within a month of the missed lesson. In some cases, a substitute may be able to cover the lesson. If the student does not wish to have a substitute and no makeup times work for the student in that teacher's schedule, a credit will be issued for the missed lesson and will be applied to the next month's bill.

## **Leave of Absences**

Youth Arts Academy offers a Lesson Hold Program, for those who will need to miss multiple lessons in a row due to vacation, etc.

Youth Arts Academy will hold the lesson spot for up to four (4) consecutive weeks at a monthly rate of \$40. This is allowed once per year. Please contact the Youth Arts Academy administrative staff to coordinate.

# **Rock Band**

## **Rock Band Fees**

YAA Rock Band students pay a flat rate membership fee to attend 60-minute weekly group rehearsals. Payment is processed the first week of rehearsal.

## **Tuition**

• \$750 for eight (8) months of rehearsals, October-June.

This rate will be prorated for students starting the program after October.

Financial Assistance is available to those who qualify. Please contact YAA@BGCSanDieguito.org to receive more information. Rock Bands will be formed based on student age, skill level, availability, and requests (siblings, friends, etc.).

#### Missed Rehearsal Due to Student Absence
